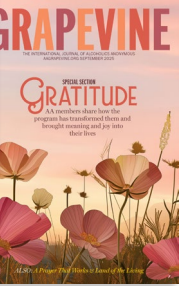
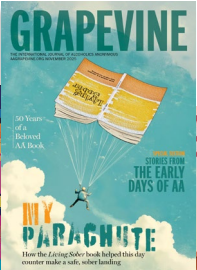
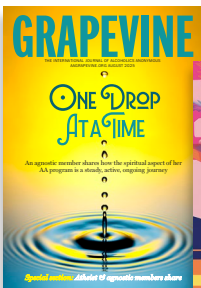

to sink deeper and deeper into despair.
My business had gotten bigger than I could manage, and I was unable to do anything to take some of the pressure off. My expenses were so high that I felt I had no other choice but to keep going. I was sobriety first in New York City, my home of 15 years, but I was terrified to leave and start over somewhere else. Where would I go? How would I make a living? Would my partner resent me for wanting to leave the city he loved?
We tried moving to a different, quieter neighborhood, but the commutes were really bad there. The structure was really bad. But my mind never stopped. Real or imaginary therapists and doctors. I sought out therapists and doctors to help switching my medications to help with my depression, couldn't leave the apartment, couldn't get out of bed. When the terrifying suicidal thoughts would stop, I was admitted to the women's wing. I was completely powerless. Where was God in all of this? I asked myself. I felt that my prayers for help were going unanswered. I felt utterly abandoned by my Higher Power despite the support I got in the rooms of AA. I'm so grateful that drinking never seemed like an option, because I know it would only make things worse and likely drive me to actually kill myself.

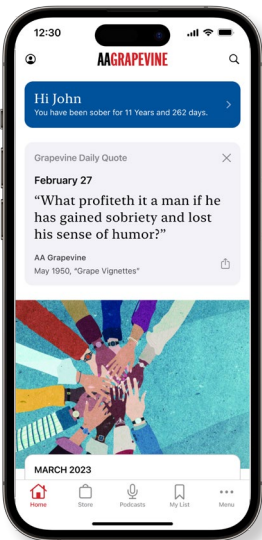
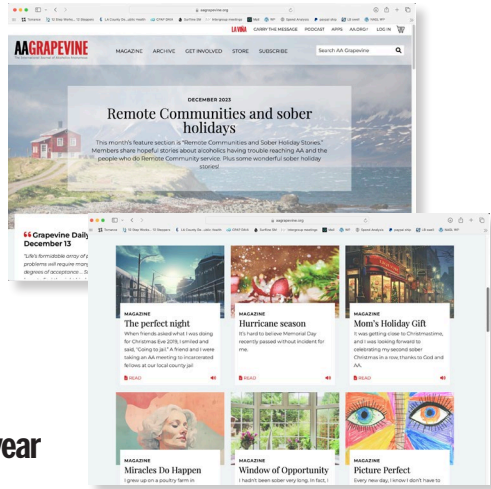

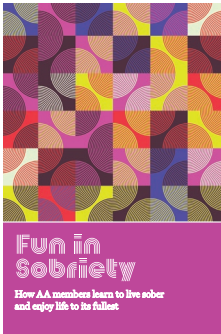


The Language of the Heart - International Convention Commemorative Edition
